## Brief History

- Today is forum's 8<sup>th</sup> meeting – 1<sup>st</sup> meeting held in January 2014
- 2014 – 2016 meetings – met 2 times each year
  - primary focus: **goals of Rideau Tay Health Links**
  - members – Board members, Executive Directors, senior staff from:
    - health service providers, primary care, community support services, social services, public health, municipal leaders, South East LHIN
  - Average number of attendees – 40 to 50 people

## Brief History (cont'd)

Purpose of GC meetings were to:

1. Have a “shared vision” of working together to achieve goals of **Health Links**
  - to deliver coordinated, efficient, and effective care to patients with complex needs
2. Develop role of Boards in supporting goals
3. Learn about gaps & opportunities in delivering integrated services
4. Network & develop relationships with other service providers

## Highlights from CG Meeting – May 26, 2017

Patients First – next phase of *Health Care System Transformation*

Lanark, Leeds and Grenville (LLG) is 1 of 5 sub regions in South East LHIN

Sub regions established to allow for **more integrated planning at local level** – to improve quality care; and to implement provincial transformation priorities

Key transformation priorities are to:

- Improve patient experience
- **Address health inequities**
- Improve access to: primary care, specialist care, mental health & addictions, home & community care
- **Support system integration** – by breaking down silos between sectors and providers
- Support innovation by delivering new models of care

## **Highlights from May 2017 (cont'd)**

### **How can Boards promote increased collaboration and integration to improve health in LLG?**

1. Work collaboratively on shared sub region goals & priorities
2. Adjust mission, vision, values, strategic plans, etc. to align with sub region goals & desired outcomes
3. Reflect goals in Executive Director's performance appraisal, annual business plans, performance metrics, etc.
4. Include as a topic on Board agendas
5. Recruit Board members with experience: from other health and social service agencies; and with transformation, collaboration and integration experience
6. Advocate for system collaboration & integration from a LLG sub region's perspective
7. Attend & support LLG Collaborative Governance meetings and education sessions
